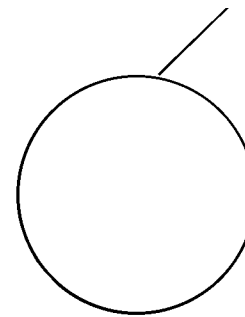
SCCMUA is conducting a smoke test of the Bath Township sanitary sewer system.

If smoke enters your home there is good reason to assume that **dangerous sewer gases** may also be entering your home or business. 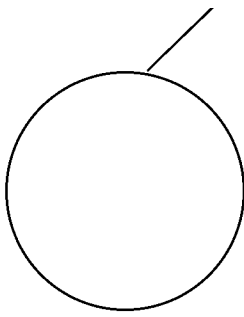

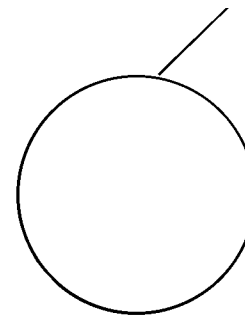
